

## Travel Time Policy

Travelling time from base to worksite is a factor for consideration prior to allocating work to any operative.

When planning work the company's Hours of Work Policy should be applied to each and every shift allocated.

Actual Travel Time should be calculated using a measureable tool such as Traffic Master or A2B Travel etc (internet based products).

Travel time should not be planned in excess of 90 minutes in either direction for any given journey to or from the site of work, except in the event of an emergency.

Where work requires initial mobilisation of resources in excess of 90 minutes travel, this will be on a single occasion to commence site activities and similarly to demobilise. During the interim work period all personnel will be lodged in appropriate accommodation local to the site of work.
